### Accessing DVR via WWW

1. First you must open your browser.
2. On the far right hand side you will see a tab saying internet options.
3. Click on it and then click on the security tab.
4. Scroll down and enable anything to do with Active X controls. (THIS ALLOWS VIDEO TO RUN ON YOUR BROWSER)
5. Then type in the IP address into the address bar of your Browser which is
6. The first time you do this it will ask you to install some software with an Active X control, click install.
7. Once you have done that you will see the DVR browser on your screen.
8. Click login then you can type the user name and password in which is by default admin admin or 666666 666666. Admin allows you to do everything over the net whereas 666666 will only allow you to view cameras only.
9. Once you have done that have a play around.
10. You can click the video tab and then the multi preview tab then 4 camera preview which will then bring up all 4 cameras at once or you can go to the right hand side and select the cameras individually.
11. If you are running Vista you will also need to go to control panel then go to user accounts and disable user account control
12. If you are running Internet Explorer 8 you will need to go to internet options -> advanced and untick enable : prevent memory manager from online attacks. Than Restart IE8
13. IE8 has a tab on or next to the address bar which enable "compatibility view" you also may need to enable this.
